#### Footnotes

<sup>1</sup> Guided electives, which include studio, liberal arts, internships, and graduate seminars, are determined by the selection of study track and in consultation with the student's academic advisor. Students in the community arts track are strongly advised to enroll in two 3 credit internships in arts organizations during Year 1 of the program.

<sup>2</sup> In addition to eligibility requirements for RISD Master's degree, MA candidates are required to: (1) enroll in Thesis Research in year two of the program, and only after successful completion of 30 credits of required course work, and (2) submit an approved thesis in partial fulfillment of MA degree requirements. An approved thesis requires the candidate to be awarded a minimum grade of "B" for the final semester of Thesis Research.
