### Curriculum notes

G = Graduate level course, open to qualified undergraduates only by permission of instructor.

All MLA students will have a portfolio and performance review at the end of each year by a panel of Landscape Architecture faculty. This review will be used to determine eligibility to continue in the program.

MLA students who finish the fall semester of their final year of study on academic probation or with a GPA below 3.0 will not be allowed to proceed into Thesis. (Note that Thesis is a requirement for graduation from the MLA program).

**Laptop Program:** Students entering the Department of Landscape Architecture must participate in its required laptop program, purchasing hardware, software, upgrades and insurance, as specified in the Department's "Laptop Program Requirements and Policy Guidelines".
