### Electronics other than TVs, monitors, or computers

If none of the above is an option, this item is safe for disposal in your regular trash. When applicable, *batteries must be removed first*. Search for **single-use, rechargeable, or long-lasting batteries** for disposal instructions. Cities and towns with automated trash collection carts require all trash to fit inside the cart. Cities and towns that empty trash by hand (using your own barrels) may have special instructions for items too large to fit in trash bags. Search for **bulky waste** to find your local disposal instructions.
